**A RESOLUTION EXPERSsing THE PROPERTY TAXATION POLICY OF THE BOARD OF
THE BUCKLIN CEMETERY DISTRICT, WITH RESPECT TO FINANCING THE 2010
ANNUAL BUDGET FOR BUCKLIN CEMETERY DISTRICT, FORD COUNTY, KANSAS.**

WHERAS, K.S.A. 79-2925b provides that a Resolution be adopted if property taxes levied to finance the 2010 Bucklin Cemetery District budget exceed the amount levied to finance the 2009 Bucklin Cemetery District except with regard to revenue produced and attributable to the taxation of 1) new improvements to real property; 2) increased personal property valuation, other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile home; and 3) property which has changed in use during the past year or with regard to revenue produced for the purpose of repaying the principal of interest upon bonded indebtedness, temporary notes or no-fund warrants; and

WHERAS, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all district services are the responsibility of the district board; and

WHEREAS, Bucklin Cemetery District provides essential services to district residents; and

WHEREAS, the cost of provision of, these services continues to increase.



Adopted this 19th day of February, 2009 by the Bucklin Cemetery District, District Board, Ford County, Kansas.


