*A resolution expressing the property taxation policy of the Board of Kiowa Hospital District District with respect to financing the 2010 annual budget for*

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b provides that a resolution be adopted if property taxes levied to finance the 2010 Kiowa Hospital District district budget exceed the amount levied to finance the 2009 Kiowa Hospital District except with regard to revenue produced and attributable to the taxation of 1) new improvements to real property; 2) increased personal property valuation, other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile homes; and 3) property which has changed in use during the past year,

Whereas, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all district services are the responsibility of the district board; and

Whereas, Kiowa Hospital District provides essential services to district residents; and


Whereas, the cost of provision of these services continues to increase.




