A resolution expressing the property taxation policy of the Board of Fire District no.1 with respect to financing the 2013 annual budget for Fire District No. 1, County of Leavenworth, Kansas

Whereas, K.S.A. 79-2925b provides that a resolution be adopted if property taxes levied to finance the 2013 Fire District No. 1 budget exceed the amount levied to finance 2012 Fire District No.1 budget, except with regard to revenue produced and attributable to the taxation of (1) new improvements to real property: (2) increased personal property valuation, other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile homes: and (3) property which has changed in use during the past year, or with regard to revenue produced for the purpose of repaying the principal of and interest upon bonded indebtedness, temporary notes, or no-fund warrants; and

Whereas, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all District services are the responsibility of the District board; and

Whereas, Fire District No.1 provides essential services to protect the safety and well being of the citizens of the District; and

Whereas, the cost of provision of these services continues to increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire District No.1 of Leavenworth County, Kansas, it is our desire to notify the public of the increases of property taxes to finance the 2013 Fire District No. 1 budget as defined above.
