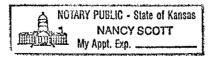

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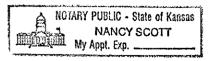

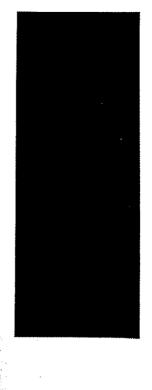

Whereas, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all district services are the responsibility of the district board; and

Whereas, Valley/Clay Drainage District No. 2 provides essential services to district residents; and

Whereas, the cost of provision of these services continues to increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the Valley/Clay Drainage District No. 2 that is our desire to notify the public of the possibility of increased property taxes to finance the 2013 Valley/Clay Drainage District No. 2 budget as defined above.
