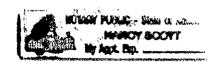

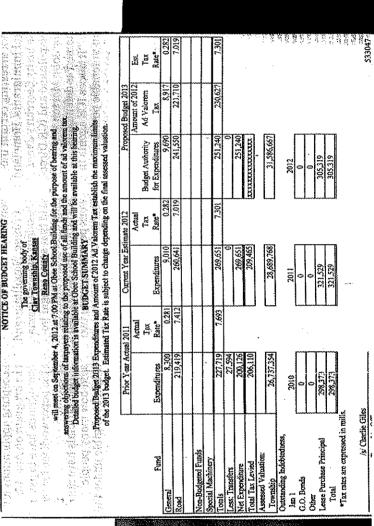

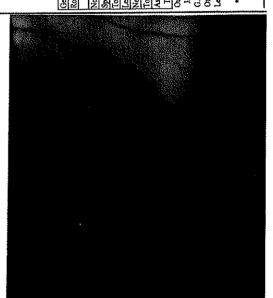

Whereas, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all township services are the responsibility of the township board; and

Whereas, Clay Township, Kansas provides essential services to protect the safety and well being of the citizens of the township; and

Whereas, the cost of provision of these services continues to increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Clay Township, Kansas of Reno County, Kansas that is our desire to notify the public of increased property taxes to finance the 2013 Clay Township, Kansas budget as defined above.
