Whereas, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all township services are the responsibility of the township board; and

Whereas, Walnut Township provides essential services to protect the safety and well being of the citizens of the township; and

Whereas, the cost of provision of these services continues to increase.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Walnut Township of Reno County, Kansas that is our desire to notify the public of increased property taxes to finance the 2013 Walnut Township budget as defined above.
