




RESOLUTION No. July 12, 1999

WHEREAS, the Great Bend Recreation Commission has been operating a public recreation system under the provisions of Article 19 of Chapter 12 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and the Unified School District No. 428 is currently authorized to levy a property tax of not to exceed four mills for the use of the Recreation Commission; and WHEREAS, the Recreation Commission has determined that the maximum authorized property tax currently being levied for the use of the Commission is insufficient to operate the recreation system, and the Commission has determined that an increase in the levy is necessary;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Great Bend Recreation Commission, that the Commission hereby requests that the maximum mill levy be increased to five mills, with the fifth mill being designated to a capital improvement fund to be used for the acquisition of sites, and for the constructing, equipping, repairing, remodeling and furnishing of buildings and outdoor facilities for recreation commission purposes and that the Commission requests the Unified School District No. 428 to authorize such an increase, in accordance with House Bill No. 2424, 1987 Session Laws of Kansas.

RESOLUTION NO. 99-1

WHEREAS, the Great Bend Recreation Commission has adopted a resolution declaring it necessary to increase the annual property tax levy for the use of such Commission to operate a public recreation system and has requested the School District to authorize a maximum mill levy of not to exceed five mills; and

WHEREAS the provisions of House Bill No. 2424, 1987 Session Laws of Kansas which takes effect July 1, 1987, authorizes the School District to provide for such an increase, subject to a petition of the voters for a referendum thereon;


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Unified School District 428, that the Great Bend Recreation Commission be authorized to levy a tax of not to exceed five mills for the year 1999 and thereafter, subject to such petition and referendum requirement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official school district newspaper and that an amount not exceeding said maximum mill levy may be levied by the Recreation Commission unless a petition requesting an election upon the proposition, signed by at least five percent of the qualified voters of the School District, shall be filed with the county election officer, within 30 days following the date of the last publication of this resolution.
