WHEREAS, the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1927, and amendments thereto, provide for such an increase, subject to a petition of the voters for a referendum thereon;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of Unified School District No. _____ that the _____ Recreation Commission be authorized to levy ad valorem property tax of not to exceed _____ mills in the tax year _____ and thereafter, subject to the aforementioned petition and referendum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official school district newspaper and that an amount not exceeding said maximum mill levy may be made for the Recreation Commission in the ensuing budget year and each successive budget year unless a petition requesting an election upon the proposition, signed by at least five percent of the qualified voters of the school district, shall be filed with the county election officer within 30 days following the date of the last publication of this resolution.
