

## **Post Implementation Evaluation Report**

### **PVD Computer-Assisted Mass Appraisal Replacement – Revenue**

Project Dates: 7/1998 through 8/2006

Project Cost: \$3,665,554

#### Project Objectives

This initiative was intended to provide Kansas county appraisers with an improved, computer-assisted mass appraisal system. CAMA is a mass appraisal tool the appraisers utilize to appraise and assess all real property in the jurisdiction each January 1. The appraisals are used for property tax purposes. The State desired to purchase a new CAMA system for each county that featured: improved analytical tools for determining estimates of fair market value; a relational database which would facilitate the interface with other assessment functions (e.g. GIS) using tier and browser based technologies.
