Transportation – Crew Card Reporting System

Project Dates: 5/2004 through 2/2009

Project Cost: **\$1,039,596**

Project Objectives

The objective of the project was to develop a stream-lined solution with an interface that is easy and obvious for maintenance supervisors (~160), their crews and administrators to use from across the state. Significant benefits were:

- To reduce labor costs spent on administrative tasks by eliminating duplication of effort for the same data that is keyed into four separate systems currently.
- At the time of discovery, capture data on a daily basis while it was still fresh in their minds.
- To work towards a paperless environment by interfacing with KDOT's document management system.
- And finally, allow the KDOT highway maintenance supervisors to spend more time with their crews in order to enhance their knowledge base to ultimately create a safer highway for the traveling public.
