

By Consideration by the State Employee Pay Plan Oversight Committee

AN ACT concerning wage and salary surveys conducted by the director of personnel services of the department of administration.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Except as otherwise provided by this section, the information contained in responses to wage and salary surveys conducted by the director of personnel services to provide wage and salary information about jobs in other public and private employment under K.S.A. 75-2938, and amendments thereto, shall be confidential and shall not be subject to disclosure under the open records act, K.S.A. 45-215 et seq., and amendments thereto, or any other statute. The information contained in responses to such wage and salary surveys shall not be subject to subpoena, discovery or other demand in any administrative, criminal or civil action. The confidentiality prescribed by this section is not subject to expiration pursuant to K.S.A. 45-229, and amendments thereto, or any other statute.

(b) The information contained in such responses to wage and salary surveys conducted by the director of personnel services to provide wage and salary information about jobs in other public and private employment under K.S.A. 75-2938, and amendments thereto, may be disclosed if no person or entity can be identified in the information to be disclosed and the disclosure is for statistical purposes only.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
